



## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between

**CYPRUS HEALTH AND SOCIAL SCIENCES UNIVERSITY(TRNC)**

and

**GEORGIAN INTERNATIONAL ACADEMY OF SCIENCES(Tbilisi-Georgia)**

**Cyprus Health and Social Sciences University**, hereafter referred to as **CHSSU**, being a legal entity and acting according to the legislation of Georgia, is legally represented under the charter by the **Rector Prof. Dr. İbrahim Levent TANER** (hereafter –First Party).

and

**Georgian International Academy of Sciences**, hereafter referred to as **GIAS**, being a legal entity and acting according to the legislation of Georgia, is legally represented under the charter by the **President Dr. Farzad Ghasemzadeh** (hereafter – Second Party)

Both of parties hereinafter separately referred to as the “Party”, collectively – the “Parties”, have decided to enter into the present memorandum of understanding (hereinafter referred to as the “MOU”) and agree with conditions as follows.

### **Article1. Purpose**

The Parties believe that the quality of research and teaching is enhanced with the establishment of international cooperation, and wish to enter into collaboration with a goal of mutual enrichment in scientific, academic and cultural areas.

### **Article2. Areas of Cooperation**

Within fields that are mutually acceptable, the Parties undertake to explore the opportunities for collaboration, which may include the following general forms of cooperation:

- 2.1. Establishment of a center for scientific, research and educational collaboration with Iranian universities at Cyprus Health and Social Sciences University.
- 2.2. Developing international collaboration of the First Party with Iranian universities in through: Signing scientific, research and educational memorandum and agreement.
- 2.3. Planning for Cyprus Health and Social Sciences University approval by the Ministry of Science, Research and Technology of Iran and Ministry of Health and Medical Education of Iran.
- 2.4. Holding international scientific conferences with the participation other universities.
- 2.5. Exchange of professors and students with Second Party’s partner universities.
- 2.6. Scientific journal production with the participation of Second Party’s partner universities in Iran.
- 2.7. Publishing joint articles with the participation of Second Party’s partner universities.

### **Article3. Obligations of the Parties**

- 3.1. The Parties intent to assist each other in achieving the objectives outlined in this MOU.
- 3.2. Each item outlined in Article 2 will be implemented through separate agreements.
- 3.3. Detailed areas of cooperation, as well as exact conditions of cooperation in each area will be described in separate agreement.



#### Article4. Financial Terms of the MOU

Based on the type of cooperation in Article 2 of the MOU, separate agreements will be signed and financial condition will be mentioned separately there. **Parties have no financial commitment to this MOU.**

#### Article5. MOU Administrators

Ultimate responsibility for this MOU lies with the rector/president of each institution, but administrative responsibility for its administration will be delegated to the following officers at each institution.

- 5.1. On behalf of Cyprus Health and Social Sciences University: Head of International Relations.
- 5.2. On behalf of Georgian International Academy of Sciences: Head of International Relations.

#### Article6. Validity of the MOU

- 6.1. This MOU starts from Dec, 2023 and will be valid for 10 years which it comes to force by signing authorized representatives of both Parties.
- 6.2. Either Party may terminate MOU by giving the other Party a six-month prior written notice.
- 6.3. The MOU may be terminated upon written consent of the Parties as well.
- 6.4. When the MOU is terminated, parties are obliged to fulfill their obligations towards all students and clients in the programs that already registered or signed contract before the ending of this MOU.
- 6.5. The terms of the MOU can be amended only upon mutual consent of the Parties, addendums and amendments are valid only if they are made in writing and signed by the authorized representatives of the Parties.

#### Article7. Signatures of the Parties

The MOU is drawn and signed in seven articles, two pages and two equally copies in English, which all of them are equally authentic and shall come into force upon the signature at both parties.

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
